SOURCE:

On 10/24/07 at 1810 hours, Cudahy Dispatcher EICHNER received a phone call from Lynn W. BRELENTHIN stating her son was assaulted by his football coach. Upon my arrival to her house, I spoke to BRELENTHIN in regards to this incident.

Upon speaking to BRELENTHIN, she wanted to file a formal complaint against her son's football coach, Michael J. CRAWLEY. BRELENTHIN stated that CRAWLEY assaulted her son by grabbing him by the facemask and slamming him to the ground.

VICTIM

INTERVIEW:

I spoke to Ryan S. MULLARNEY in regards to this incident. MULLARNEY stated that while at practice at Cudahy Middle School, his coach grabbed him by the facemask and slammed him on the ground. MULLARNEY stated that he was learning a new position as a split end. MULLARNEY stated that during a play, he made a block on another student, who he identified as "██████". MULLARNEY stated that "██████" was the son of CRAWLEY.

MULLARNEY stated that he was assisting another teammate in performing a two-person block on "██████". MULLARNEY stated that he made a legal block on "██████". He hit him around the waistline, knocking him to the ground. MULLARNEY stated that "██████" began screaming and appeared to be injured while on the ground after he blocked him. He stated that after he made the block, he was approached by CRAWLEY, at which time he grabbed him by the facemask, picked him up and slammed him on his back. MULLARNEY stated he got the wind knocked out of him.

MULLARNEY stated that CRAWLEY was yelling profanities at him as he approached him. MULLARNEY stated that CRAWLEY said, "mother fucker," "bastard" and also called him a "son of a bitch." MULLARNEY also stated that Coach CRAWLEY yelled, "I'll fucking kill you."

While speaking to MULLARNEY, he appeared to be visibly shaken from this incident. MULLARNEY stated he was fearful at that time of the incident. While speaking to him, MULLARNEY kept rubbing his right shoulder and neck region. I asked MULLARNEY if he was injured, at which time he said his neck hurt.

MULLARNEY was crying during the interview and was showing significant signs of fear over the whole incident.

WITNESS

INTERVIEW:

I spoke to Brian D. MOLNAR in regards to this incident. MOLNAR, an assistant football coach, stated that he was present for the incident.

MOLNAR stated that MULLARNEY was learning a new position on the football team. He stated that after he made a legal block on CRAWLEY's son, "██████", "██████" was injured. MOLNAR stated he immediately went to assess the injury to "██████" at which time he observed CRAWLEY approach MULLARNEY in a threatening manner. MOLNAR stated he observed CRAWLEY grab MULLARNEY by the facemask, pick

him up over his head and slam him to the ground. MOLNAR described the incident as a "WWF body slam." MOLNAR then stated after CRAWLEY slammed MULLARNEY to the ground, he began yelling profanities at him. MOLNAR stated CRAWLEY yelled "fuck" numerous times and overheard him threaten MULLARNEY by stating, "I'll fucking kill you, you son of a bitch." CRAWLEY had to be forcibly restrained by other coaches to get him away from MULLARNEY.

MOLNAR stated that he was unable to assist with the incident, due to him helping the injured player on the ground. He stated after the incident happened, CRAWLEY attempted to pick his son up off the ground, at which time he told him not to touch him because he believed he was injured. MOLNAR stated he assisted the injured boy to CRAWLEY's vehicle and CRAWLEY left the scene. CRAWLEY then left the school by squealing his tires out of the parking lot.

MOLNAR stated that practice was immediately cancelled after the incident occurred. MOLNAR stated that it was one of the most frightening experiences that he has gone through. While speaking to MOLNAR, he also appeared to be very highly disturbed from the whole incident, and appeared to be emotionally shaken.

WITNESS
INTERVIEW:

I spoke to Bryan D. ALLARD in regards to this incident. ALLARD stated that he was also an assistant coach for the Cudahy Bulldogs. ALLARD stated that he did not observe MULLARNEY getting slammed to the grounds, but observed CRAWLEY's tirade afterwards. ALLARD stated CRAWLEY used profanities "at the top of his lungs" and caused a big disturbance. ALLARD overheard CRAWLEY yell "fuck," "mother fucker," "bastard," "son of a bitch" and numerous other profanities during his tirade. ALLARD stated he had to forcibly remove CRAWLEY from the football field and away from MULLARNEY.

VICTIM
TRANSPORT:

After taking the above statements, BRELLENTHIN took MULLARNEY to St. Luke's South Shore to be treated for possible injuries he sustained during the assault.

SUSPECT
CONTACT:

After taking the initial complaint and statements from witnesses, I attempted to make contact with CRAWLEY at his residence at 3750 E. Martin Ave. Upon pulling up to that location and knocking on the front door, I was met by CRAWLEY by the side door. Upon making face-to-face contact, CRAWLEY stated, "I'm the guy you're looking for." I then asked CRAWLEY what happened, at which time he stated he "lost his cool." I then instructed CRAWLEY to meet me at the police department so he could provide a statement as to the accounts of the incident.

A short time later, I spoke to CRAWLEY at the Cudahy Police Department, in the crisis room, in regards to this incident. CRAWLEY stated that he was an assistant coach for the Cudahy Bulldogs. He stated that just prior to the incident happening, he observed

MULLARNEY take a "cheap shot" at his son. CRAWLEY stated that MULLARNEY used an illegal chop block on his son, the result of which injured his son.

CRAWLEY stated that after he observed his son get chop blocked, he ran out on the field to ask MULLARNEY why he did it. He stated that as he approached MULLARNEY, he began yelling, "What are you doing," numerous times. He stated that as he got right up to the pile, he observed MULLARNEY kneeling over his son, laughing at him. CRAWLEY then stated again, "What are you doing," at which time, MULLARNEY turned to him and laughed in his face.

CRAWLEY stated that he "lost it" and grabbed MULLARNEY by his facemask and threw him behind him, away from his son. CRAWLEY stated that at no time did he pick MULLARNEY up over his head and slam him as other reports of the incident stated. CRAWLEY then stated he began yelling profanities towards MULLARNEY and towards the other coaches.

CRAWLEY admitted that what he did was wrong and stated he merely "lost his cool." CRAWLEY stated at no time did he intend to hurt MULLARNEY, but merely was trying to get him away from his son.

CRAWLEY stated that prior to police contact he was at the emergency room with his son. "██████," had a deep thigh bruise and was scheduled for an MRI on his left hip on a later date.

CRAWLEY stated MULLARNEY has hit his son in a "cheap shot way" before. He believes MULLARNEY is a dirty player and thought it was an intentional hit.

CRAWLEY didn't want to provide a written statement.

I informed CRAWLEY that our department would be seeking charges against him through the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office. CRAWLEY was ordered in to the Milwaukee County District Attorneys Office on 10-31-07 at 0830 hours for a charging conference. Our department will formally book him after charges if any being filed by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.

She has requested the treatment records from St. Luke's South Shore Hospital and will make them available to the police and District Attorney's Office.

I informed Ms. BRELENTHIN that Michael CRAWLEY was interviewed regarding this complaint and has an order in date for the District Attorney's Office for the matter to be reviewed for criminal charging. Ms. BRELENTHIN was displeased that CRAWLEY was not in custody and she expressed fear of him. She said that up until this incident she and CRAWLEY were friends. She requested information regarding a restraining order and I gave her an instructional package.

I then spoke with Jack LITTMANN, the Director of the Bulldog Football Program. He told me he was present and observed this incident. He said, "Our coach went nuts, he (CRAWLEY) picked up the kid and threw him to the ground and then stood over him and said, 'I'll fucking kill you s.o.b.'" I told LITTMANN that the District Attorney's Office will review this case for criminal charging and LITTMANN replied that he (CRAWLEY) should be charged with a crime. I then expressed BRELENTHIN'S fear that CRAWLEY could be present and cause problems at future games. LITTMANN said he has instructed CRAWLEY that he is not welcome to be present during any Bulldog game or practice. I asked LITTMANN to call the police department if CRAWLEY does show up.

INTERVIEWS
10-28-07:

I spoke to Kevin A. REMSZA in regards to this incident. REMSZA stated he observed CRAWLEY throw MULLARNEY to the ground. He then saw CRAWLEY standing over MULLARNEY pointing his finger at him yelling profanities. He overheard CRAWLEY yell, "I should fucking kill you."

I also spoke to numerous other concerned parents who wished to remain anonymous in regards to this incident. Many of those parents stated that their children came home crying over the incident. Some of the children didn't want to play football again. One of the parents I spoke with said their child said, "If Coach Crawley coaches basketball I'm not going to play."

VICTIM'S
INJURIES:

MULLARNEY suffered a strained neck and a contusion to his right shoulder. MULLARNEY was given a sling to wear for his arm.

DISPOSITION:

This case will be presented to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on 10-31-07 for charging. Our department will be seeking charges for Physical Abuse of a Child and Disorderly Conduct.
