THE ABOVE NAMED COMPLAINING WITNESS BEING DULY SWORN SAYS THAT THE ABOVE NAMED DEFENDANT(S) IN THE COUNTY OF MILWAUKEE, STATE OF WISCONSIN.

COUNT 01: BATTERY

On October 24, 2007, at 5530 S Barland Av, City of Cudahy, did cause bodily harm to Ryan M. by an act done with intent to cause bodily harm to Ryan M. and without the consent of Ryan M. contrary to Wisconsin Statutes Section 940.19(1).

COUNT 02: DISORDERLY CONDUCT

On October 24, 2007, at 5530 S Barland Av, City of Cudahy, a public place, did engage in violent, abusive, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud, and otherwise disorderly conduct under circumstances in which such conduct tended to cause or provoke a disturbance, contrary to Wisconsin Statutes Section 947.01.

AS TO COUNT 01:

Upon conviction of this charge, a Class A Misdemeanor, the maximum possible penalty is a fine of not more than \$10,000 or imprisonment for not more than 9 months or both.

AS TO COUNT 02:

Upon conviction of this charge, a Class B Misdemeanor, the maximum possible penalty is a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 90 days or both.

Complainant states that he is a Police Officer for the City of Cudahy Police Department who bases this complaint upon his review of the reports of fellow officers, whose reports he has reviewed and relied upon in the past and has found them to be truthful, accurate and reliable:

City of Cudahy Police Officer Andrew Kitzrow interviewed citizen/victim Ryan M., who states that he was born on August 11, 1995. Ryan indicates that on October 24, 2007, he was playing football at a location in Cudahy of 5530 South Barland Avenue. Ryan indicates that he was playing opposite the defendant, Michael Crawley's, son, and he executed a block on Crawley's son that ended up hurting the son. Immediately thereafter Michael Crawley, the coach for his son's team, ran out onto the field and approached Ryan M. He then grabbed Ryan M. by the facemask and picked him up off of the ground. He slammed him down onto the ground again, causing Ryan to land on his back. Ryan states that he got the wind knocked out of him, and he suffered a bruised shoulder blade bone and a sore neck. As a result, Ryan was in pain and was also in a sling for a few days. Ryan indicates that Crawley was also yelling profanities at him as he approached and as he was grabbing him and after he had slammed him onto the ground. Ryan states that he was saying words like, "motherfucker", "bastard", and calling him a "son of a bitch." Ryan states that Crawley was yelling these things at him into his face. Also, Crawley yelled, "I'll fucking kill you."

Officer Kitzrow also spoke with citizen/witness Jack Littmann, who indicates he is the director of the Bulldog football program. Littmann described that he was present at the location and time of the incident, and saw what happened. He stated about Crawley, "Our coach went nuts, he picked up the kid and threw him to the ground and then stood over him and said 'I'll fucking kill you s.o.b.'"

Officer Kitzrow also spoke with Michael Crawley. He indicates that Crawley was cooperative when the police arrived, and indicated that he had "lost his cool". Crawley went on to describe that he believed that Ryan had done an illegal chop block on his son, and when he observed what happened, he, Crawley, ran out onto the field and asked him what Ryan was doing. He said he was yelling and as he got right up to the pile he believes that Ryan was laughing at his son. Crawley described that he "lost it" at that point and grabbed Ryan by his facemask and threw him behind him, away from his son. Crawley admitted that what he did was wrong and again stated that he had "lost his cool." He indicated that at no time did he intend to hurt Ryan, but was merely trying to get him away from his son.

This does not exhaust all the information available in support of this complaint.
