The above named complaining witness, being duly sworn, on information and belief states that the above named defendant, in the County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin, on May 8, 2007 at 2213 A N. Barlett Street, City of Milwaukee, did knowingly obstruct a law enforcement officer while such officer was doing an act in an official capacity and with lawful authority, contrary to Wisconsin Statutes Section 946.41(1).

Upon conviction of this offense, a Class A Misdemeanor, the maximum possible penalty is a fine of not more than \$10,000 or imprisonment for not more than 9 months, or both.

I am a City of Milwaukee law enforcement officer and base this complaint upon the statement of Detective Victor Wong, that on the above date, at the above place, he responded to a complaint of a sexual assault. Officer Michael Cameron arrived first on scene and observed the defendant screaming and crying in the stairwell of the residence. Officer Cameron, at the time of the above incident, was on duty and dressed in the official uniform of his department, bearing official insignia identifying himself as a law enforcement officer. The defendant stated that a black male, approximately 6'00", wearing a dark hoodie, blue jeans, and white tennis shoes sexually assaulted her. The defendant stated that the black male had ejaculated on her robe before fleeing the scene. The defendant was taken to the Sexual Assault Treatment Center, cried uncontrollably, and pulled a clump of hair from out of her head. The defendant complained of pain to the back of her head and vagina area.

As a result of the defendant's complaint, the police canvassed the area around the defendant's home, collected evidence, interviewed more than 20 individuals from the neighborhood for information that would lead to the apprehension of a possible suspect, viewed video surveillance from a house adjacent to the defendant's house, and retrieved cell phone records.

The defendant made a statement against her penal interest to Detective Vickie Hall. The defendant stated that the sexual allegation she claimed was false, that she made up the allegation because she felt guilty about cheating on her fiancé, and that she made up the allegation for attention. The defendant stated that she came up with the description of the suspect from a newspaper article or t.v. show. The defendant further stated that a black male was stereotypical of a rapist.
